Overview

This seminar describes China securitization and the analysis of transactions, based on three pillars: the underlying pool of assets, the transaction structure, and the legal aspects. It covers both the general principles found throughout the China securitization market, as well as specific characteristics of several of the main asset classes, including residential mortgages and consumer loans. The course also gives an overview of the publicly available rating methodology and monitoring practices of our sister company, Moody's Investors Service. The course employs a combination of instructor-led sessions, case studies, group exercises, computer-based simulations and discussions.

- » understand the mechanics of a China securitization transaction, including the roles of the major participants
- » interpret the varying rationales of market participants for issuing or buying securitized product in China

- » anticipate the main legal issues that are likely to arise regarding a China securitization
